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Holiday Park Information

Health and safety

First Aid kits are located at reception and an AED is located on the back wall by the outside seating area.

Caravans must have a current Electrical Warrant of Fitness. You will not be able to plug in without it. Tents are to have an approved RCD cord if it is to be used for power in the tent. These are available for hire from reception if necessary.

We are committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for our guests and staff. Our hazard register is available for viewing at reception. Emergency procedures are located at reception and all amenities blocks.

Any persons deemed to be placing themselves or others at risk by Christchurch Spencer Beach TOP 10 Holiday Park staff may be asked to leave immediately.

Sites

Tent walls and caravans are to be at least 1.5 metres from the site boundary. If no boundary is marked then a gap of 3 metres between the walls of tents or caravans on your site and ones on the adjoining site applies. This is a requirement under Fire and Campground Regulations. All vehicles, tents, caravans, boats and other equipment are to fit within your reserved site.

Check out by 10:00am

Please check with reception before 10:00am if you wish to stay extra nights so we can confirm availability and adjust your booking.

Visitors

Visitors must report to reception and depart Christchurch Spencer Beach TOP 10 Holiday Park by 10:00pm. The site holder is responsible and accountable for any visitors behaviour and actions. Visitors will incur a charge over the peak summer period. This is payable at reception.

Children

Parents and caregivers are responsible for the behaviour and safety of children in their care. Children should not be roaming around the site or congregating in communal areas after 10:00pm.

Internet

Pets

Pets are welcome from the 1st May – 30th September.

Terms and conditions apply.

Camping only, not in accommodation and must be arranged with the Park prior to your stay.

Roads and vehicles

Speed limit of 10km is strictly enforced within the Holiday Park for vehicles, battery or fuel.

Our roads are a 'Shared Zone' for all pedestrians, bikes and vehicles. **Watch out for children.** General road rules for the safe use of vehicles apply. Do not drink and drive.

Motorized recreational equipment such as quad bikes, go-karts, dirt bikes, (including electric/battery-operated models like Surrans and similar e-motorcycles), and any other non-licensed motorized off-road vehicles are strictly prohibited in the campground. The only exceptions are low-powered, pedal-assist e-bikes and e-scooters, which must adhere to speed limits and road rules.

Bikes and skateboards

Helmets must be worn by all cyclists and skateboarders. Please stay out of the amenities blocks.

BBQ's, Fires and Fireworks

Only Gas BBQ's are allowed in the park, ensure all BBQ's are safe to use and gas is turned off after use. No solid fuel BBQ's, cookers or smokers are allowed.

We have a complete fire ban all year round in the holiday park. No open fires or fireworks are allowed. This also applies to the Spencer Park picnic area, beach and forestry plantation.

Noise

Quiet time is between the hours of 10:00pm and 7:00am. Any disruptive or excessive noise at any time of the day will not be tolerated. As a guide, if you can be heard more than a site away then your noise will likely be considered disruptive. No music or stereos after 10:00pm.

Smoking

All our communal buildings, accommodation and the immediate area surrounding them are smoke free. You may smoke on your site but please be respectful of others camping around you, your smoking should not adversely affect others.

Alcohol

Alcohol is only permitted to be consumed on your site, do not walk around the holiday park with open alcoholic beverages. Excessive drinking and disruptive parties are forbidden.

Anti-social behaviour

We reserve the right to request guests or visitors to leave our facility, who are deemed by staff to be behaving in a socially unacceptable way.

These behaviours include: causing damage, excessive noise, disturbing others, unacceptable language, excessive intoxication, aggressive or argumentative attitude.

No refund will be given and charges will apply for any damages caused.

Quiet time is from 10:00pm to ensure all guests have an enjoyable stay.

Guests must make themselves familiar with our holiday park rules at the time of check in.

Note that Christchurch Spencer Beach TOP 10 Holiday Park has security cameras operating with 24hr recording.

Any breach of the above rules could result in your immediate expulsion from the holiday park without a refund and forfeiture of any rebook status. The site holder is deemed responsible for those staying on the site.

Drones

No drones or other flying objects are permitted onsite.

Paddling Pools

No paddling pools allowed, with the exception of small Clamshell pools under 250mm in height. These must be first approved by camp management, be contained within the site, and actively supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.
