Holiday Park Information

Health and safety

A First Aid kit is located at Reception.

Caravans/campervans require a current Electrical Warrant of Fitness displayed and comply with LPG Standard (As/NZS3100). Tents are to have an approved RCD cord if it is to be used for power in the tent.

We are committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for our guests and staff. Our hazard register is available for viewing at Reception. The emergency assembly point is located at the children's playground.

Parents are responsible for children's safety and well-being.

Any persons deemed to be placing themselves or others at risk by Akaroa TOP 10 Holiday Park staff may be asked to leave immediately.

Sites

All vehicles, tents, caravans, boats, and other equipment are to fit within your reserved site.

Check out by 10:00am

Please check with Reception before 10:00am if you wish to extend your stay so we can confirm availability and adjust your booking. Please bring keys to Reception if you are staying in a cabin/unit.

Visitors

Visitors must report to Reception and depart Akaroa TOP 10 Holiday Park by 10:00pm. The site holder is responsible and accountable for any visitor's behaviour and actions. Visitors will incure a charge over the peak summer period and public holidays. This is payable at Reception.

Internet

Our internet is provided with unlimited data on a limited band width.

Pets

Strictly NO PETS

Roads and vehicles

A walking speed limit of 8km is strictly enforced within the holiday park for all vehicles.

Our roads are considered public roads and the same rules apply. Do not drink and drive.

All other powered vehicles that are not registered for road use are prohibited i.e. quad bikes, dirt bikes and motorised go carts.

Bikes and skateboards

Safety and consideration to other guests is critical when riding bikes, skateboards, or scooters. Helmets must be worn when riding bikes. As a safety measure, bikes, skateboards, and scooters are not to be ridden in the park grounds once the park lights come on and must be away at nightfall They are not allowed around the communal blocks or on decks. Any found in these areas will be removed.

Boat Parking

There is limited space for boats and jet skis. It is a first come first served basis for these spaces. If there are no boat parks left they must be parked on your own site or out on the road.

Fires/BBO's

We have a complete fire ban all year round in the holiday park. No open fires, charcoal BBO's or fireworks are allowed

Noise

Quiet time is between the hours of 10:30pm and 7:30am. Any disruptive or excessive noise at any time of the day will not be tolerated. Report any undue noise to Reception (03 304 7471, available 24 hours)

Smoking

In compliance with New Zealand law, smoking and vaping are not allowed in any public buildings, communal areas or accommodations. If you wish to smoke or vape, please do so away from the vicinity of buildings and other guests.

Alcohol

Alcohol is only permitted to be consumed on vour site. DO NOT walk around the holiday park with open alcoholic beverages. Excessive drinking and large parties are forbidden.

Anti-social behaviour

We reserve the right to request guests or visitors to leave our facility, who are deemed by staff to be behaving in a socially unacceptable way.

These behaviours include: causing damage, excessive noise, disturbing others, unacceptable language, excessive intoxication, aggressive or argumentative attitude.

Quiet time is from 10:30pm to 07:30am to ensure all guests have an enjoyable stay.

Guests must make themselves familiar with our holiday park rules at the time of check in.

Drones

Strictly no drones or other flying objects are permitted onsite (we are under a flight path for the Westpac Rescue Helicopter)

No water bombs

Be kind to the environment and use a water pistol rather than a water bomb. Water bombs create a big mess that won't biodegrade very quickly.

Behave!

Note that Akaroa TOP 10 Holiday Park has security cameras operating with 24hr recording.

Any breach of the above rules could result in your immediate expulsion from the holiday park without a refund and forfeiture of any rebook status.
