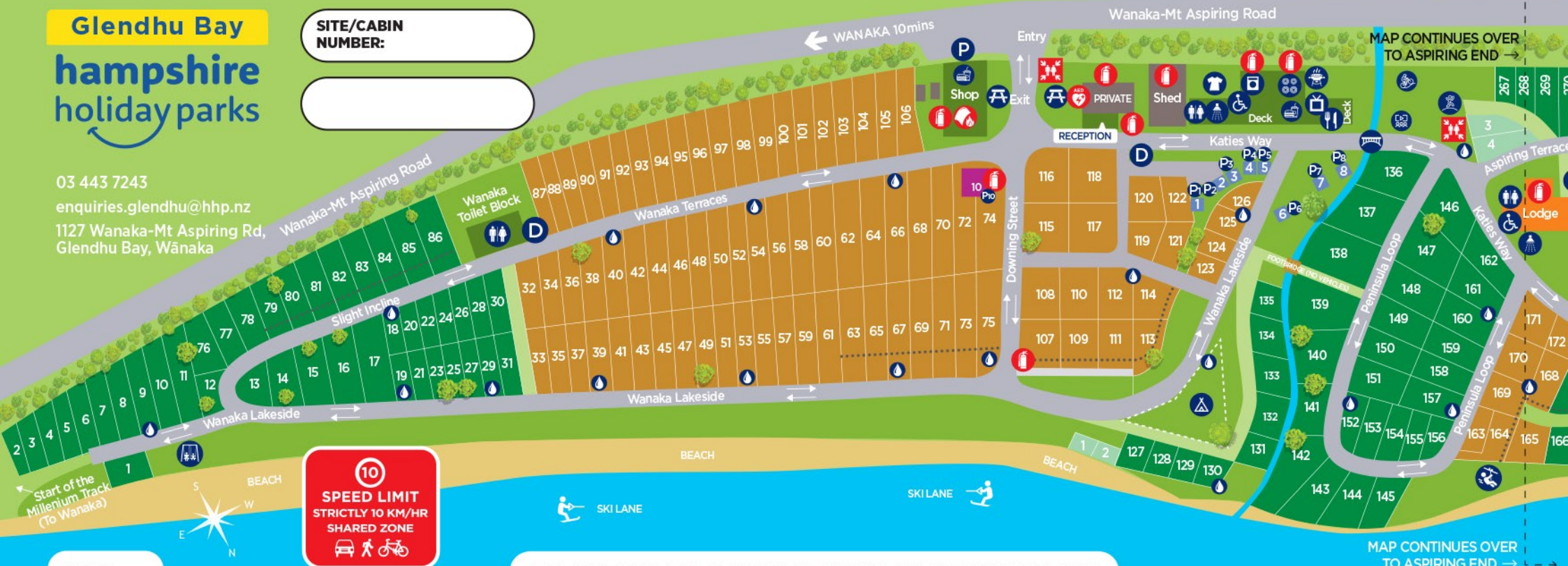

BASIC RULES & CONDITIONS OF OCCUPANCY

ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE

Check-in from **2pm**. Check out by **10am** for roofed accommodation, **11am** for camp sites, unless previously arranged. Late departure may result in additional charges.

OFFICE HOURS

9am-5/6pm during off-peak seasons. 8am-8pm during peak season.

VISITORS

All visitor vehicles **MUST** be parked outside the park at all times. Visitors must report to reception on arrival (and leave the camp by 8pm). If visitors are staying overnight with you, they must check-in at reception on arrival and pay the appropriate camp fees.

SPEED LIMIT

The speed limit for ALL vehicles, including scooters, bikes and e-bikes, is strictly 10km/h.

CONDUCT

Silent hours are between 10pm and 7am – no exceptions. All guests should show consideration for other campers by keeping noise levels down at all other times. Please notify the office if you are being disturbed by noisy guests via the Intercom outside of reception. Glendhu Bay is a family camp with a zero-tolerance policy for any violence, offensive language and/or abusive behaviour.

BARRIER GATE

The entrance gate is open all year round except for a few days over the Christmas/New Year period. Please ask at reception.

ELECTRICAL WOE

Your caravan, campervan or motorhome must have a current electrical warrant before you can plug into our sites.

FIRE REGULATIONS

All tents/caravans/campervans must be at least 1.5m from the site boundary lines. Accessways (marked in light green) must be left clear at all times. Permission is ALWAYS required from reception before lighting any fires anywhere on the park.

DOGS/PETS

Pets are not permitted in the camp from the 20th December until after Waitangi Weekend. Pets must always be on a lead and not left unattended at any time. All dog waste must be collected and disposed of appropriately in rubbish bins. No pets are allowed in any of the buildings.

SHOWERS

You can pay for your shower by scanning a QR code in the shower cubicle or using \$2 coins. \$2 = 6 minutes of hot water. Reception can swap \$2 coins for you.



CAMP SERVICES

LAUNDRY

The machines in the main block laundry can be paid for by scanning a QR code or by using the iPad/EFTPOS/PayWave terminal. The machines in the Aspiring Amenities block only work via QR code. Laundry powder can be purchased from reception or the vending machine in the main block laundry.

RECYCLING & RUBBISH

Rubbish bins and recycling stations are located around the Park. Check the labels on the bins before depositing your recycling. Only plastics 1, 2 & 5 are accepted and must be rinsed and tops removed (place tops in normal rubbish). Soft plastics and food trays go into the red lid bins. Thank you.

DUMP STATIONS

There are 3 dump stations in the Park: Outside reception office, at the Aspiring amenities block, and at the Wanaka toilet block.

GREY WATER

Must be taken to a grey water sump adjacent to the above dump stations or at the Swing block toilets. Do not empty at tap stands.

WIFI

Unlimited WiFi is available throughout the Park (trees may limit reception in certain areas).

BBQ

The BBQs are for all guests to share and enjoy. Please ensure you leave them clean after use and place all rubbish in the bins provided. Please do not move the picnic benches in the BBQ area.

WATER ACCESS FEES

All trailered watercraft brought into the Park must pay our water access/boat ramp fee and display a current sticker on their boat trailer. Your trailer and vehicles must be parked back on your site while you're out on the water. Alternatively you can reserve one of our dedicated boat/trailer parks. Ask at reception.

- Evacuate to your nearest Emergency Muster point (noted on map)
- Assist any person in immediate danger, but **DO NOT RE-ENTER** until given permission to do so
